

General information

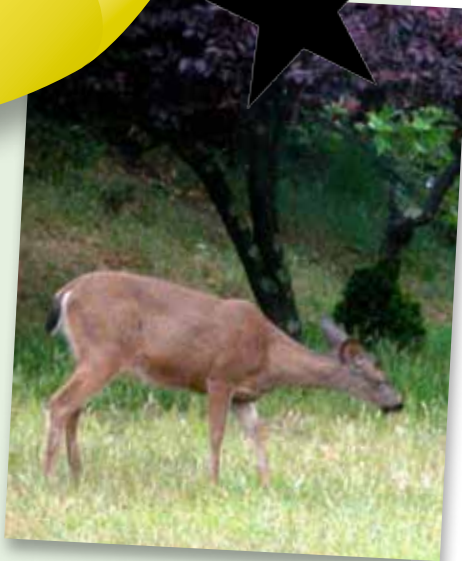

What is FAB Camp?

Family Arts Bridge or FAB Camp (for short) is an arts-based non-profit family camp for all kinds of families representing diverse backgrounds, particularly families with lesbian/gay/bisexual/transgender members and their friends!

FAB Camp is Arts Galore!

FAB Camp is adults, children, and families getting creative together doing activities such as: making music at the family jam, learning hip hop dance, making costumes, singing rounds, learning theatrical improv techniques, and listening to stories...

Family Camp is Fun for Everyone!

FAB Camp is people of all ages hanging out together, splashing and boating in the pond, playing ping pong, relaxing with friends, hiking around the trails, going on bike rides, watching (and perhaps participating) in talent shows, and playing games... FAB Camp creates a safe, inclusive, and relaxed atmosphere for both children and adults.

Family Activities

In the afternoons the most popular activity tends to be hanging out at the swimming pond. Families might also choose to explore the wading creek, hang out in the gardens, go hiking, play ping-pong, participate in the intergenerational arts activities, or just relax with friends. Each evening there are planned family activities as well, such as games in the lodge, a campfire with s'mores and singing, and a camp dance.

Arts & Recreation Programming for All Ages:

Children's Program

There is daily programming for all children led by highly qualified and enthusiastic staff. Each day arts specialists lead developmentally appropriate activities for each age group.

Teen (& Pre-Teen) Program

This year we are excited to offer two great options for the middle-and-high-school aged young people.

Option 1: Performance Arts Focus

Meet with an arts specialist every day, working on a production that you perform on the last day of camp!

Option 2: Universal Camp Experience

Try a little bit of everything! Work with various artists and enjoy a range of camp activities, such as hiking, sports, games and hanging out with your group.

Adult Options

While the children are with their counselors in the morning, adults have the options of enjoying the site on their own or, participating in organized arts activities (music, dance, drama, or visual arts) tailored for adults only.
